The most recent outcome data from 2013, as reported in February 2015, from the society of Assisted Reproductive Technologies (SART) reveals some interesting trends in the use of banked oocytes. 2013 is the first year that the clinical experience with banked donor ova has been documented on a national basis.

**Frozen Oocytes Produce Normal Births**

Often, infertility patients wonder whether the technology will affect the outcome of their babies. We have been reassured by several reports regarding the obstetrical outcomes and risk of birth defects with human oocyte cryopreservation.

Chian et al.(2008) reported on the obstetrical outcomes of over 200 babies resulting from oocyte vitrification in three centers, comparing them to spontaneously conceived, or ART conceived neonates. Mean birth weights and rate of anomalies was similar.

**Comparing Egg Banks**

The ability to preserve human eggs has been a "home run" in reproductive medicine. Previously hindered by technical difficulties, in experienced hands currently, eggs which have previously been cryopreserved with the vitrification method now approach the performance of freshly retrieved eggs. This is a great development that has several important applications - couples may wish not to have all their eggs inseminated in order to reduce the number of "excess" embryos produced in their IVF cycle. Women may wish to freeze their eggs in order to preserve their reproductive potential as they age.
