Zika Virus and Donor Eggs

Zika has been a hot topic in the United States lately. Although there have been no cases of Zika being transmitted from a donor egg to a recipient or their offspring, the FDA has enacted new guidelines that does not allow egg

donation from donors in Zika areas. These Zika areas include Mexico and most of the Caribbean Central and

- Egg Survival 91.8%
- Clinical Pregnancy per thawing 48.4%*
- Embryos Transferred to each Patient (Many eSETs) 1.41
- Transferable or Freezable Embryos for each Cohort of Eggs 2.61
- * Clinical pregnancy is based on heartbeats and is per thawing, not per Cohort of Eggs

South America. Recently, two areas in Florida have been added to this list. Potential donors that have traveled to these areas within the last 6 months, have had sex with someone that has visited these areas in the last 6 months, or has had a diagnosed Zika infection within the last 6 months are excluded from donation.

Prior infections of Zika do appear to provide immunity to Zika infections. A prior Zika infection protects one from a subsequent infection, but how long that protection lasts is unknown.

The World Egg Bank follows the current guidelines from the FDA and does not allow donors that have visited or lived in Zlka areas to donate. As a recipient, it is important to not travel to Zika areas if you are pregnant or planning to get pregnant.

The CDC reports that the best way to protect you from Zika are:

- Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants.
- Stay in places with air conditioning and use window and door screens to keep mosquitoes outside.
- Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)registered insect repellents with one of the following active ingredients: DEET, picaridin, IR3535, oil of lemon eucalyptus, or para-menthanediol. When used as directed, EPA-registered insect

repellents are proven safe and effective, even for pregnant and breastfeeding

In July, The European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology held its annual conference in Helsinki, Finland. It was attended by over 8,000

reproductive specialists worldwide. The World Egg Bank had an exhibit booth, and plenty of doctors, nurses, donor coordinators and embryologist to speak with.

Egg donation is very restrictive in many European countries. As The World Egg Bank complies with legislation for screening donors in all European countries, we can provide access to our donor eggs to couples seeking our assistance to conceive, without traveling abroad. We ship donor eggs directly to your fertility specialist. If their own countries greatly hinder or fully restrict the use of donor eggs. we have a location in London, UK, that infertile women can go to in order to have our eggs warmed, fertilized and transferred as embryos. There are many advantages to using our top quality donor eggs:

- A recipient can stay 'at home' with their own doctor
- A recipient can make the short and relatively inexpensive flight to London to receive our donor eggs
- You will receive the donors photos, and full application, complete with donors reported medical history
- You have the choice of an anonymous donor, or a donor who is willing to release her identity should the recipient or child chose to contact the donor in the future.
- You will have an unparalleled choice of egg donors to find a best match with your own family profile

A Family is Anchored in Relationships, Not Genes

I don't often share my personal

experiences about infertility. After 20 years of talking to thousands of women who have or are going through infertility, I know there is no such thing as a typical experience that can be addressed with simple advice or direction. My own story clearly illuminates that! Every person enters my world of donor eggs at very different emotional stage in the process and each has a unique resolution based on their own financial resources, level of support from family or friends, knowledge of the 'science' behind egg donation, personal resilience, determination, physical stamina, strength of their partners (if they have one), and so on.

Having said that, I have seen common experiences and believe that in sharing some of my own story, I can help remove some barriers that we encounter and some we create for ourselves. From my own experiences, I have woven a philosophy into The World Egg Bank that speak to the needs of infertile women. It is the relationship that builds a family.

 Treat clothing with permethrin or purchase permethrin-treated items. exist as an option. After 15 years of IUI's, clomid, laparoscopies (5), lab tests, 3 IVFs with my own eggs, and considerable debt, I ended this painful phase of my journey without a baby and with a diagnosis of "unexplained infertility." I was left with a pretty big 'empty nest' to say the least. I was going on 40 years old, had lived in two countries (Canada and the U.S.), was peaking in my 15 year career, traveled extensively, lost my father and a brother to cancer, bought/renovated 3 homes, and all of these experiences only strengthened my desire for a child. Some people are able to find resolve and comfort in their decision to be childless, I was not one of them. I tip my hat to people who can choose to be or remain childless, because I truly believe that is the right choice for them.
